

# **Decorative Panel Installation Guide**

### Important notes

Before installing the panels, the installer and the owner must make sure that the wall complies with the conditions specified in this document. The installer and the buyer have the responsibility to inspect the panels upon reception of the goods. If the installer doubts the panel, the manufacturing or finishing quality and cannot place it in a less conspicuous place, nor eliminate imperfection, he/she should not install it. Once the panels are installed, this shall be considered as having been accepted by the installer and the owner even if the latter is absent at the time of installation.

The customer must make sure that the product purchased is suitable for the desired installation. Once again, if you have any doubts or questions, please contact our customer service department. Since Impex Stone has absolutely no control over the proper preparation of the surfaces, the method of application or the ability of the installer, no guarantee on the implicit or explicit result can be offered.

### Step 1 – Tools required

In preparation for the installation, make sure you have the following tools on hand:

- Hammer
- ¼ drilling mesh
- Drill
- Measuring tape
- Level

## Step 2 - Surface preparation

Careful preparation is an essential step to the success of the final result. Most problems attributed to panels are, in fact, caused by an improper preparation of the surface which must be clean, uniform, free of dust, dirt, oil, wax, mold, powder, flakes, etc.

### Step 4 - Installation

- 1. Open all the boxes, take out the panels and choose them according to the desired effect.
- 2. Select the location of the first panel to be installed.
- 3. Place the template, level it and mark the location with the use of screws.
- 4. Drill the holes with ¼ mesh for anchor placement.
- 5. Place the anchors in the wall and hammer it to make it flush.
- 6. Drill in the screw leaving ½ inch and place the template to make the proper adjustment.
- 7. Tighten screws so that the template is pressed against the wall but has enough space to move up and down.
- 8. Lift and remove the template and place the first panel in place.
- 9. Place the template on top of the installed panel and refer to step 3 to 8 for each panels.

#### Maintenance

## Wash with water and soft soap.

#### Warranty

Impex Stone decorative panels have a limited warranty of 1 year from the date of purchase (proof required) when the installation is done in accordance with the recommendations of the National Building Code and the installation guide included in the product specifications of the manufacturer. The original invoice from the authorized dealer must be supplied.

The warranty does not cover any damages resulting from:

- Improper installation.
- Wall movements due to the subsidence of the soils or other causes.
- Contact with chemical products, paint or others.
- Discoloration due to polluting atmospheric agents, water or friction.
- Stains, oxidation, discoloration and fading due to polluting atmospheric agents or any external agents.

This warranty only covers Impex Stone defective products. It does not include labor and is limited to the original buyer.
